Leg Umpire Guidelines EDCL Regulations

- 1. The square leg umpire must be a playing or non-playing member of the team and must uphold the highest standards of fairness and impartiality at all times.
- 2. A leg umpire must not engage in scoring duties simultaneously while umpiring.
- 3. The umpire shall not coach, signal, or communicate with players while the ball is in play. For instance, giving instructions to batters or fielders is strictly prohibited.
- 4. While umpiring, individuals must set aside their team association and act with utmost neutrality and integrity.
- 5. If the official umpire instructs the captain to replace the leg umpire due to conduct or competence, the change must be made immediately and without confrontation.
- 6. EDCL encourages captains to assign capable and experienced players for leg umpiring duties.
- 7. Minors are not permitted to serve as leg umpires due to safety concerns and the potential risk of injury.
- 8. If the leg umpire needs to provide water or assistance, it must only occur between overs and must not delay the progression of the game.
- 9. The leg umpire must stay alert to key responsibilities such as run-out decisions, beamers, and stumpings, and should not chase the ball or turn away from play during live action.
- 10. The main umpire holds the authority to overturn any decision made by the leg umpire if deemed necessary.
